



Fundamentals of Voice and Data Cabling - Alignment to BICSI, Registered Installer, Level I

The Fundamentals of Voice and Data Cabling course, along with supplementary materials available through Cisco Press and job experience, will help students prepare for the BICSI Level 1, Installer exam.

The BICSI Level 1, Installer exam is two parts, including a written exam and two hands-on tests. You must pass both to become a Registered Level 1, Installer. If you pass one test, and fail another, you can retake that test individually at a later date. Once you pass both tests you can continue along the BICSI certification path by completing on-the-job training.

In order to prepare for the exam, BICSI has determined the materials needed to study for the written exam and hands-on tests. The Fundamentals of Voice and Data Cabling course and supplemental materials from Cisco Press, will cover this information in detail.
