Linux⁺

Linux⁺ certification is a CompTIA-sponsored testing program, which measures foundation-level Linux operating system proficiency. This certification is appropriate for individuals who are interested in demonstrating fundamental Linux knowledge and skills.

The exam covers basic installation, operation and troubleshooting services for the Linux operating system and hardware on workstations and servers. Sys Admin basics are also part of the Linux⁺ learning objectives.

The Cisco Networking Academy Program's *Fundamentals of UNIX, along with IT Essentials II: Network Operating Systems*, will help prepare students to take the Linux⁺ exam. The test is available globally in English and German.
